At the heart of the capital of gastronomy, the 62 rooms of this hotel offer you the exceptional experience of contemporary comfort and the typical charm of authentic XIVth, XVIth and XVIIth century residences.

Preserving the history and the charm of exposed stonework whilst dressing it up with stunning modernity..... that is the spirit found in every room. The hotel is located in Vieux Lyon, comprising the largest Renaissance quarter in France. This area's most intriguing features are the traboules - secret covered walkways creating a labyrinthine network between streets. Dating back to the Renaissance, these passageways proved useful during the French Revolution, and WWII Resistance.

Here the apartments, suites, duplex and other triplex symbolise all by themselves the magical spirit of a unique place in Europe.

This hotel has 62 guestrooms, all of which are decorated with antique furniture gathered from nearby brocantes (flea markets), hand-painted frescoes by Hervé Thibault, and parquet flooring. Rooms overlook the interior courtyard (windows are frosted) or the peaceful rue du Boeuf. Many of the rooms have beamed ceilings. Rooms have wireless internet access (surcharge). The bathrooms, designed by Philippe Starck, display his characteristic theatrical touch with ruched curtains and bath large enough for two.

The hotel also offers a heated indoor swimming pool and dry sauna. Terraced gardens at rooftop level with gazebo.
