

This four-star luxury inn with a terraced pool, renowned restaurant and luxury suites with hilltop views over Umbria's green hills to the Sibillini Mountains.

Spello, an ancient Roman town, clings to the slopes of Monte Subasio. You enter the little walled town through the Porta Consolare or the Porta Venere, both of which date from the time of Augustus.

In the historic center is an old mill which still has certain elements of its original architecture, such as the arches in the reception rooms. The new rooms and the two suites, one which has a mini swimming-pool on its private terrace, are the most comfortable. The others still have somewhat old-fashioned bathrooms. While all the rooms are light and comfortable (although with minimal storage space), ask for the ones on the upper floors on the terrace side. They have a view of the countryside, as the restaurant can be noisy. The swimming pool also enjoys this panoramic view over the olive groves and the valley.

The restaurant, awarded the Michelin Star, offers its guests an innovative approach to the local Umbrian cuisine.
