Nestled on the hillside of this ancient chateau village, this cottage invokes a timeless sense of charm and beauty. The house has been fully restored and tastefully redecorated - handmade Italian tiles, crisp white linens and antique and leather furniture throughout. Large chestnut wood-beamed ceilings in living room and bedrooms. Massive stone fireplace with stove insert and antique copper accents.

The fully equipped kitchen offers fridge, microwave, gas range and stove. Other amenities include linens and towels, clothes washer and dryer, phone, TV, DVD player, iPod docking station, CD player/radio

The village consists of a cluster of golden-stone houses beneath a dramatic 500 foot cliff. Perched at the top stands the 12th century Chateau, rising from the sheer cliff face along the most historic and scenic section of the Dordogne River. Situated on a footpath leading to the Chateau, your medieval adventure awaits. Step inside into a quiet retreat and enjoy the charm of its thick stone walls and heavy chestnut timbers. Some of its furnishings date back to the 1700's. The wonders of old Perigord are at your doorstep!

This house makes for an ideal home base for visiting all the picturesque villages in the Perigord Noir, including Domme, Les Eyzies, Beynac, La Roque-Gageac, Castelnaud, Monpazier, and Sarlat.
