

La Terrace, Beynac DORDOGNE

- Three-bedroom village house – Sleeps with 6
- Small swimming pool

This 15th century house was completely restored with a focus on its original character and charm, with modern facilities. Very comfortable and cool in summer thanks to its stone walls. You will be captivated by its location in the heart of the village and its exceptional panoramic views of the Dordogne River and the neighbouring castles.

The kitchen is fully equipped and the dining room and living room open onto the terrace. Opening out onto the outside terrace is the wooden floored lounge with its stone walls and framework of beams. Outside, there is a covered summer terrace with a BBQ, and the swimming pool boasting breathtaking views of the River.

On the ground floor with access to the garden, there is a lovely bedroom with a double bed and its own ensuite shower and toilet. Upstairs there is the main bedroom with a double bed and a second bedroom with 2 single beds. The bathroom and toilet are separate.

Beynac is located in the golden triangle of the Black Perigord - an exceptionally scenic area of the Dordogne packed with interest year-round. Pathways leading along the river take you to/past impressive castles, delightful gardens, quiet lanes of small villages or lead you up to craggy-top ridges high above the river. Kayaking the river is another favourite way to explore this area. This medieval village with its 12thC castle and cobbled streets has kept its authenticity. The lifestyle attracts artists and all who enjoy wandering the streets, visiting the shops, and enjoying a coffee or lunch at one of the small local restaurants.
