

*Maison des clés*, Ansouis PROVENCE

- 4 bedrooms and 4 bathrooms
- Swimming pool, tennis and pétanque courts

This original old Provencal farmhouse and property have been fully restored into a luxury, 4-bedroom villa with pool, terrace and shared tennis court. The house is situated in five acres of land in an idyllic setting of vineyards, olives and green oaks. With a view of the famous Ansouis Chateau from nearly every room, and across the Luberon behind.

You enter this house on the ground level into a large open-planned dining room and spacious lounge with an adjoining modern kitchen. There is also a second separate TV lounge, and a laundry room on this level. The kitchen, which looks out onto the patio, swimming pool, is fully equipped including Smeg stove and oven and wine fridge.

The 4 bedrooms are on the second level, up a winding staircase. The master bedroom with a double king bed has a walk-in dressing room and en-suite with shower. The other large bedroom has a super king bed and an en-suite with bath and shower. The other two bedrooms each have a bathroom. One has a double bed and bathroom with bath and shower opposite. The fourth bedroom has two single beds and a bathroom with shower and hand basin, with a separate toilet.

The swimming pool is at the front of the house, with access to the tennis court at the bottom of the fields - racquets available on request. And a “boules/pétanque court” alongside the main drive. From the terrace, which is alongside the 8m x 4m swimming pool (depth of 1.1m to 1.5m) and a large shady tree with lawn, you look out over a beautiful valley, with the chateau taking centre stage. There is plenty of very comfortable patio furniture and water small water fountain provides the soothing sounds of trickling water. The property is accessed via an electric gate, has plenty of parking, and EV charger available for guests.

Ansouis, crowned by its 1000-year-old castle, is a member of the select group worthy of being one of The Most Beautiful Villages in France. Both village and castle are marvellously well preserved, with houses dating back to the 15th century. Located within walking distance, there are a couple of excellent restaurants, a café, bakery and grocery store.
